LIFESTYLE AGREEMENT for Servant Volunteers (continued)

Following are several examples from the Bible of what it looks like for someone to follow biblical standards and live the Christian life:

- uphold the God-given worth of human beings, from conception to death, as the unique image-bearers of God (Gen. 1:27; Psalm 139:13-16)
- be people of integrity whose words can be fully trusted (Psalm 15:2-4)
- show evidence of the Holy Spirit who lives within them, qualities such as “love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control” (Gal. 5:22, 23)
- give faithful witness to the Gospel (1 Pet. 3:15), practice good works toward all (Gal. 6:10; Eph. 2:10), and live lives of prayer and thanksgiving (1 Thess. 5:16-18)

By contrast, the Bible instructs us to refrain from sinful attitudes and behaviours, such as:

- rage, slander, dishonesty, hatred, selfish ambition, idolatry (Col. 3:8-9; Gal. 5:19-21)
- sexual immorality, such as the use of pornography (Matt. 5:27-28), pre-marital sex, adultery, and all other sexual relations outside the bounds of marriage between a man and woman (Rom. 1:21-27; 1 Cor. 6:9-10)
- hypocrisy, self-righteousness, legalism—imposing extra-biblical standards of godliness upon another person (Acts 15:5-11; Matt. 23:13-28)

Following the Lifestyle Agreement

It is important to recognize that none of us have perfectly followed these biblical standards and lived the Christian life fully. We are all imperfect human beings, but we are committing ourselves to not staying where we are but following Jesus in living life as He intended it to be lived. The most important thing is not our perfection but our direction—being willing to follow Jesus in every area of our lives and allowing Him to change us day by day.

Following this Lifestyle Agreement may on occasion require that we take steps to hold one another accountable, challenging one another in love as we walk together and learn to live the Christian life and be faithful to God’s Word and to our own word. Such loving acts of confrontation are at times difficult, but when performed in the right spirit (Gal. 6:1), they serve to build godly character for the individuals involved as well as the community as a whole (Matt. 18:15-17). Only in this way, as we are willing to speak the truth in love, will we “grow up into him who is the Head, that is, Christ” (Eph. 4:15).

NOTE: If you are not a follower of Jesus yet, you are still welcome to be a part of Centre Street Church and serve together with us in certain volunteer roles. You may not be able to say that you believe in all that the Bible says or that you are a committed follower of Jesus, but if you can agree to live according to biblical principles then you can serve at Centre Street Church. Please check the box below indicating your commitment to doing so.

LIFESTYLE AGREEMENT for Servant Volunteers

The goal of the Servant-Volunteer Process at Centre Street Church is to have the right people, serving in the right places, with the right heart and for the right reasons.

The purpose of this Lifestyle Agreement is to:

- Enable us to pursue living in biblical community as fully devoted followers of Jesus Christ
- Empower us to fulfill the mission of Centre Street Church.

It is important that what we believe and what we do goes together. In all we do, we want to live in a way that honours the Jesus we are serving.

Biblical Standards

We understand that, through the Bible, God calls to us and encourages us to respond to Him in a number of ways:

1. The call to love God with our whole being, and to love our neighbour as ourselves (Matt. 22:37-40). Christ-like love should be the motive in all decisions, actions, and relationships (Rom. 13:8-10).
2. The call to acknowledge the Lordship of Christ over all of life. This involves a wholehearted obedience to Jesus and careful stewardship in all dimensions of life (1 Cor. 10:31; Col. 1:18; 3:17).
3. The call to actively pursue holiness in every aspect of our thought and behavior (2 Cor. 7:1) and to treat our own bodies and those of others with honor due the very temple of the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 6:18-20).
4. The call to participate in the worship and activities of the local church, which forms the basic biblically-mandated context for Christian living (Acts 2:42-47; Heb. 10:25).

Living the Christian Life

We believe these biblical standards will show themselves in a distinctly Christian way of life, an approach to living we expect of ourselves and of one another. This lifestyle involves pursuing and practicing those attitudes and actions the Bible portrays as virtues while avoiding those that the Bible portrays as sinful and destructive.
